

During the season, amongst the signs and omens which you perceive from the land, one stands out. Rhyv and Mawrig conjoin in the West Marshes – a storm of blood? No: that reading is too simplistic. And besides, this is not the Jotun – for Bravash shows its face only inverted or reversed. A subtler sign, but enough to make the point. The opposite of fertility is not death, but toxicity.

Magic, then. Destruction, blood, toxicity: there is venom in the West Marsh, a poison in the land. It could be anything – a plague of insects devouring crops, the fouling of the marsh-water, a blight hollowing out good vegetables. And when you try to look into its cause, there it is over and over: Bravash inverted, Bravash reversed. If you cast rune-stones, the Bravash stone always lands on its end, and then falls – the wrong way.
