

Senator,

I have the sombre duty of informing you that several properties in Sarvos will be publicly auctioned off at the summit this solstice. These are the resources of citizens of Sarvos who sadly perished during the Grendel occupation of Cignos, and for whom there have been no inheritors, successors or readily available purchasers. Each of these will be auctioned off including all fixtures, rights, licenses and stock; the actual matter that will be placed on the auction are the letters of rights, the reports of the civil service administrators and any goods of note that remain. Obviously, as per normal procedures, citizens wishing to take on the ownership of any of these may need to set aside existing property interests as appropriate.

For auction will be:

The Falerni Vinyard, a farmed estate in the Sarvos countryside and of prestigious name. Giacomo Falerni died defying the Grendel in Cignos, and has no successors or inheritors.

The Narrenhaus, an asylum for treatment of the mentally unwell and attached congregation in Cignos itself. Lisette di Bocchelare, previous head priest of the Narrenhaus, was killed by the Grendel while evacuating her patients during the occupation and a new head priest is required.

The Scaligeri Kennels, a business in Cignos that breeds and trains hounds and other animals. The entire Scaligeri family were executed by the Grendel in retaliation for what seem to be Grendel casualties at the jaws of Scaligeri-trained hounds.

As all three of these are in Sarvos, I considered it appropriate to let you know of their forthcoming sale should you know of relevant parties who may be interested in taking on their stewardship.
