

SPYING IN LIATHAVEN, SUMMER 379YE

The spy network in Liathaven requires a minimum of five hundred force committed to it if it is to provide valuable information. Between Owyn and Kellag you only manage around two-hundred and forty force.

Your troops are able to confirm which the regions of Liathaven are still in Jotun hands (West Ranging, Liath's Ring and Liaven's Glen), which are still dominated by the Vallorn (Liath's Heart and Westwood) and which are technically in the control of the Navarr (Western Scout and Beacon Point). The southern Navarr regions are still cut off from the rest of the Empire by a combination of Vallorn and the bandits of the Kharaman peaks

– but efforts appear underway to provide a fortified steading to serve as a base of operation for those still in Liathaven to fight off the bandits raiding from the south and the Jotun raids from the west.

There is certainly at least one Jotun army in Liathaven, but it is impossible for you to be entirely sure there is only one. Your troops do not report any new fortifications, but absence of proof should not be taken as proof of absence.

The Jotun continue to be give Liath's Heart and Westwood a wide berth – although they seem to have established lightly garrisoned watch posts at several of the conquered steadings near the vallorn controlled areas.

In several places in Liath's Ring, spies report encountering the heads and body-parts of Jotun scouts hanging from trees. Some are reminded of the tactics of the destroyed Dance of Blood army, others of those employed against the Lasambrians during their short, ill-fated foray into southern Liathaven. The remnants are most common near the Trods. About three weeks ago, the same scouts report seeing a band of Navarri around Liath's Ring with bandaged eyes, engaging in a merciless assault against a Jotun patrol. Information is scattered, but the Navarri appear to be engaging in a spirited defence of a strong Spring regio in the southern part of the region. Someone appears to be fighting back - but they do not seem to be reaching out to the rest of the Navarr for assistance.
