

Over the season, and with increasing regularity as the equinox approaches, you are dreaming of the Jotun. In fact, you are dreaming of *being* a Jotun.

In one scene vivid, you open a door into a great long hall with a roof of beams and thatch. You are carrying a tray with several goblets of mead, which clatters to the ground as you drop it, mouth agape. There are streaks of blood splashed on the walls, and the bodies of several wealthy looking Jotun lie strewn about, throats slit and knife wounds to the back. There are still warm plates of food on one of the long trestle tables, but not a living soul to be seen. Composing yourself, you flee the room to raise the alarm.

In another recurring dream, you stand at the foot of a hill among massed ranks of Jotun warriors, chanting and cheering. In the distance you can hear human voices, also raised in exaltation of the battle they are witnessing. Atop the hill, one female Jotun and a human dressed in tunic, chain and leather clash are fighting a duel, lit up in red by the setting sun. Over and over again they clash, wounding each other grievously.

The other dreams you have are of battle. In some you are fighting alongside the Steinr against other orc tribes whose dress and clothing you do not recognise. Your force is unstoppable and you crush these lesser tribes underfoot. In others you are fighting against the Steinr, and these battles seem much more evenly matched; two forces standing toe to toe trading blows and battle cries. You never see a Kallavesi or Suaq in any of these dreams, or indeed any other human or orc nation that you recognise.

You can sometimes here the voice of a particularly strong female ancestor, urging you to investigate the catacombs under Kalpaheim, in Kalpamark, Wintermark.

OOO note: The quest to the catacombs is a low combat quest for 5 people only. There is no reason you couldn't have checked the conjunction time on your way into Anvil if you so choose, your egregores should be aware of the time. Be aware it is on the Friday night of the event.

The 12 breaths pilgrimage will come later in the weekend and will be for the whole nation as normal
