The influence of the Black Plateau still oppresses you even at Anvil. You suffer bouts of melancholy and despair and sudden paranoia, and your dreams are full of blood and savagery. You also suffer occasional short-lived hallucinations that are uniformly unsettling, threatening, or bring you sorrow.

Roleplaying Effect: any dark or violent emotion - fear, anger, hate, jealousy, or sorrow - is greatly amplified. When in the throes of one of these emotions it is easy and satisfying for you to lash out verbally or physically at those around you.

You find it difficult to accept that you are under the influence of an outside force - these surges of emotion feel entirely natural to you. These sensations surge and recede; the curse is most likely to impact the roleplaying of your character at dramatically appropriate moments.

Game Information: While under this effect of this curse you should respond with a passionate outburst of an appropriate dark emotion to any roleplaying effect that attempts to dampen or control your emotions, or to create feelings of calm, clarity or tranquillity.
