Over the past three months, a number of Thule warbands of varying sizes have been sighted at **The Face of Ikka** in Wintermark. Though most of them still remain, one of the smaller bands – known extravagantly as **The Black Heart of Karsk** – travelled to **Oloy**, in **Karsk**, within the last few weeks. raiding the shipments of Ambergelt from the **Krevasty Yelta** – though these raids seem opportunistic – if anything, incidental to the warband's movements. We don't know why a single group of Thule would force-march all the way from The Face of Ikka in Sermersuag to Krevasty in Karsk. This in itself is suspicious.

The Spellbinder for The Black Heart took a small retinue with him - we predict somewhere around 30-50 troops in the immediate vicinity.
The Civil Service have identified a conjunction to Oloy in the next few days. We predict a high chance that a very small band of capable individuals could sneak in and gain an advance on the Thule's plans by stealing the Spellbinder's book and any plans for the war effort in Karsk.
