

Message in a Bottle

This is your first and final warning:

This ritual will only work for those who have been specifically authorised by Roshanwe, or their individual named proxy or successor, as named to Roshanwe prior to the attempt.

Attempts to learn or to use this ritual otherwise will invalidate the compact that underpins it.

This ritual sends documents to Roshanwe, the Walker on the Littoral. She may, at her option, return some of the Water of the Day Realm to the caster.

Performing the Ritual

References to Sular, Ophis, the Door, the Key and the Phoenix are especially appropriate, as is the Mixolydian mode, and the Bishop with the Lantern, Cloak, Ring or Coin in the Chamber or the Library.

The Bishop in the Chamber with a Cloak reading either the material to be sent or something related would be a particularly relevant dramaturgical performance.

Setting out the Door, invoking it, carefully marking the Phoenix, and then placing the documents in a position representing the Key and tracing all three constellations while invoking Roshanwe's name would be a relevant Astronomantic performance.

Performing the Ritual

Performing this ritual takes at least 2 minutes of roleplaying. This ritual targets a single book, pamphlet, bundle of letters, scroll or tablet or similar written work that must be present throughout.

Effects

When the ritual is complete, the target written work disappears and is received by Roshanwe herself.

This ritual will only transfer a scroll, pamphlet, tablet, book or similar piece of written work.

Roshanwe is aware of who sent the item and whether Weltsilver was used to power the ritual, and may at her option return a single vial of Water from the Day Realm.

Options

The ritualist may use 2 measures of Weltsilver as part of the ritual, which will be consumed at the completion of the ritual. Every two ingots used in this way reduces the magnitude of the ritual by 1.

OOC note

This item is a ritual text.

Any character with the Day Ritual Lore skill can master this ritual. You must have a free slot or experience point to master a new ritual. After an appropriate period of roleplaying spent studying these pages, it should then be brought to a referee who will add the ritual to those you have mastered. Doing this does not 'use up' the ritual text.

This ritual cannot be learned by other means; it cannot be taught by a character who knows it unless the ritual is added to the body of Imperial Lore by the Conclave.
