



## Imperial Civil Service Report

Subject: Sejanus of Shatterspire's True Liao Vision
Report: As directed, I have been looking into the past
life vision received by Sejanus Shatterspire of Urizen
We have been able to find some references to an Anion
Sunspire, who lived during the reign of Emperor Nicovar, and
who we believe to be the Vicionary's past-life.
Records from the period are understandably incomplete
