

Investigation Report

Introduction

Following the Autumn summit at Anvil, I was tasked to track down Guillmero i Marco i Riqueza for questioning. Guillmero was identified as having employed a group of League mountebanks to commit crimes in League territory.

Initial Investigations

Over the past three months, our enquiries reached a number of dead ends as Guillmero seemed not to want to be found. We eventually managed to track Guillmero to Bramar in Feroz where, we believe, he was attempting to leave the Empire.

The Lodgings House

We eventually received a tip-off that Guillmero was attempting to contact owners of vessels prepared to transport him with no questions asked. Details were to be left at a lodgings house owned by a Cristo i Verra i Erigo.

I led a group of militia to the lodgings house to question Cristo and in case Guillmero was present. We arrived just as a Sutannir was attempting to leave in some urgency. On a hunch, I instructed the Sutannir to be detained. Entering the premises we found a Hakima sat and waiting, and I requested they also be detained. The Hakima indicated that the lodgings owner was not present, but that Guillmero was, and indicated Guillmero's room.

Upon entering Guillmero's room, I saw a corpse on the floor, which was later identified as Guillmero's. Both the Hakima and Sutannir claimed to know nothing, and to have heard nothing.

The militia searched the premises and found two other guests at the lodgings; a Highborn and a Navarr. Neither claimed to know what had happened, or to have heard anything.

Subsequent Actions.

During our investigations, the owner of the lodgings, Cristo i Verra i Erigo, returned. We questioned Cristo, and the interview is enclosed as a separate document.

A review of the lodgings indicate the windows and back door were locked, and the only way in or out was through the front, which was past the Hakima and in view of other citizens in the street outside. These witnesses report Cristo leaving, and the Hakima and the Sutannir arriving.

There was a raucous celebration in the street outside, and the lodgings rooms have been reinforced for the privacy, and discretion, of guests. The claims that none of our four primary suspects heard anything are plausible.

Consequently, I am confident that only the four individuals we currently have detained had the opportunity to kill Guillmero. There is no connection between them we can identify.

The crime scene is preserved and the suspects available for questioning, once the Portal opens from Anvil to Bramar.
