When the Herald's of the Prince of the Argent Tontine spoke to me about placing some Low Tontine entries in the hands of someone known in the Empire for their wealth, there were choices to be made.

Many might have thought I would turn to Lorenzo, builder of Great Works or to the heirs of Achilles if they were known, but I turn to you, Cardinal. For it is my belief that though the Sovereign Lord of the City of Chains is oft described as only meeting the dark side of greed and desire, that making alliances with him, with care and a wise negotiator to aid can be a true route to Prosperity.

Indeed I have heard it rumoured that there is a lost Exemplar of Prosperity in the Brass Coast who was so tightly bound to the Prince that Callidus protects his legacy even now.

Whether you agree or not is a matter for another time. The matter in hand right now is this: I have 25 entries to the Low Tontine, each of current value 2 crowns. I am sending them to you via Navarri post – you might make the runners task easier if you were kind enough to leave word at the Hub as to where you can most easily be found.

I leave it to you whether you wish to enter the Noisy Play yourself and win more and more and show that the Prosperity Assembly can gather together much of the wealth that the Tontine offers, or whether you wish to trade them or even to give them to those at the beginning of their journey in Prosperity, for whatever loyalties their greed will give to you.

Should you not have heard of the Tontine, you only need to look to the Hub in Anvil. I am told that arrangements have been made for posters reminding people of the rules to be displayed therein.
