One star that cannot be mistaken is that of the Empress. There are many in her near orbit, among them, unexpectedly, the star of

a Dawnish Yeoman with a sometime interest in night magic.

Among the stars that represent the Generals of the Marches, one carries with it a shadow, like the essence of a star that could have been.

If the Loom is turned to spin the stars as they might be placed by the Jarls of the honourable Orcs, then one Imperial star from the Brass Coast, with political power of her own, is held higher than any other Imperial star.

Among the swirl of stars that represent many of the Marcher heros, loyal and protecting their land, there is at least one that was not forged Imperial, but that is made of the stardust that represents the Feni.

A merrow of considerable Imperial standing, influence and military prowess has a star which shows the tarnish of a terrible darkness in their past.
