

You have heard of an influx of "Grimmelkint" Spring boggarts into Imperial territories, which are taking a special interest in forests. You may have even encountered one of these strange creatures yourself, either in your forest or on the road to Anvil. They are humanoid, with growths of bark, flowers or fungus on their faces, and seem to want to eat the natural materials produced by forests.

Attempts to simply kill these strange creatures have been unsuccessful, leaving the attacker feeling unwell, and another boggart soon cropping up in its place. For the moment they are just a nuisance, but left alone they may begin to affect the production of forests in imperial territories - including yours!

You also know - either from personal experience, or second-hand from someone else - that they are somewhat more cooperative when treated with hospitality and offered gifts of food, herbs, or shiny things. For example, various Varushkan vales have had success with this approach, though it is costing them a lot of resources to keep up.

It's not quite enough to get them under control, but it's a start...
