Esteemed Burgher,

The following letter was awaiting for you upon your arrival at Anvil along with a package containing a mirror of black glass.

Karg i Estrico i Erigo,

Please accept the condolences of both myself and those I represent: we are enjoined in our suffering under the grasping tendrils of the Nemorian foe. I pray to the gods that your home and mine in distant Marracossa will, in time, be rebuilt through our cooperation and the just devastation of the children of Asav.

The actions of the Imperial armies have preserved Trajadoz and we have opened our gates and estates to shelter caravans and columns moving to and from the fronts. Our walls have been restored and redoubled through the fruits of your labour at the markets of your capital: though yet untested, we are eager to see Asaveans dashed against their battlements.

*Your efforts in gathering and executing our request shall not be taken for granted - many of our sons and daughters were so moved as to seek to aid in taking the fight to the foe. Such experience will go far in ensuring the quality of our artifice is kept sharp. We extend our utmost thanks - and hope in time we can find a means to return this effort in kind: whether you remain our *Sendito* or otherwise.*
