Supplement 1: The Metempsychotic Anointing

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The Importance of the Metempsychotic Anointing

The journey into the Labyrinth of Ages is not trivial, nor lightly embarked upon. Souls frequently emerge from the Labyrinth disorientated, and injuries and traumas of the mind, not to mention spiritual conditions requiring Exorcism, may be inherited. Over the last four centuries the Imperial Civil Service has undertaken considerable research into ensuring the experientially consistent return of those who enter the Labyrinth alive.

The Metempsychotic Anointing is a simple rite in two parts which helps to focus the Questors' minds and wards them against the greatest perils of traversing the Labyrinth of Ages. As a Gatekeeper of Virtue, this is traditionally your responsibility to perform as you see fit. This guide defines the bare bones of the ICS Standard Rite, but Gatekeepers are free to employ regional and theology-specific methods.

The Metempsychotic Anointing is not a metaphysical rite, as Anointings of Virtue are; however, the Gatekeepers of Virtue may take the opportunity to discuss formal Virtue-Anointings with their Questors and perform them if appropriate.

Anointing of the Questors with the Guardian Runes

The Guardian Runes, painted on the forehead, are protective for obvious reasons. Lavender oil or simple pigments are traditionally used, but even a dry-brush anointing will suffice.

Upon the Visionary:

Cavul surmounts Diras.
Irremais surmounts Wyr.
Cavul dominates Irremais.
Diras dominates Wyr.

Purity/clarity drawn from hidden-things. Wisdom drawn from mystery. Purity/clarity is paramount over wisdom. Secrets must be knowable to be known.

Upon the Guide-Priest:

Sular surmounts Ophis. Evrom surmounts Yoorn.

Discovery in interpreting revelation.
Beginnings surmount endings.
ENSURE THIS IS ACCURATE.
WE CANNOT STRESS THIS STRONGLY ENOUGH.

To help guide the **Questors** to a place of Virtue, the Virtue of their Dedication should be detailed at the centre of the arrangement (marked with a [*]). If either is Undedicated, substitute the Rune of Destiny, Gralm. See diagrams beneath.

N.B. The form given is for right-handed Questors, as these are in the majority. In the case of left-handed Questors, reverse the form along the vertical axis.

Anointing of the Questors with the Destiny Runes

These Runes aid the Questors in returning to their current life-path.

The Visionary should be Anointed with the Rune Feresh on the palm of their sword-hand. The Guide-Priest should be Anointed with the Rune Irremais on the palm of their sword-hand.

Each Questor should receive the Rune Gralm on the palm of their off-hand.
