To the Virtuous Citizens of the Chapter of Felix's Watch:

I write today to inform you of my work to explain the Way of Virtue correctly to my peers, my creator and other creatures of the Day Realm. I fear that thus far my efforts have met with little in the way of concrete success. The servants of Roshanwe say my evidence is insufficient for my claims – indeed, that no evidence can be sufficient, and therefore my evidence-based argument for the Way is unconvincing compared to their approach (which is based on unfalsifiables, and therefore to my reason intrinsically unwise).
