Imperial Seer,

Greetings from the Augurs of the Opalescent Gloaming. We hope you are finding the Hawk's Demeanour and the Waters of the Shimmering Shore to be worthy contributions to your title, and that you are able to put them to good use in service of the Empire.

We are writing because we wish to warn you. We have been happy to see some of the veils and shrouds blanketing the Empire lifted away; what is a seer who cannot see, after all? Once again, magicians of Day can look upon our lands and guard against threats.

However, we have cast the runes and examined the portents, and it has become clear to us that we are not the only ones taking advantage of the return of clear skies. Skarsind has been subjected to the scouring gaze of another — someone has been scrying upon it repeatedly since the shroud was lifted from it. Who they are, and why they are doing so, is not clear to us — the auguries do not reveal their name or nature to us — but we have not heard of any Imperial coven taking responsibility for it. We fear it may be an outside force.

How you might discover the truth, we leave in your capable hands — but we would recommend that the All-Seeing Eternal Kimus would likely be a source of knowledge worth calling upon. If there are any of the Realm of Day that would know the source of the scrying, it would be Kimus — and they have been noted as rarely being so partisan as to withhold this sort of information from those who would ask.

However, there may be some difficulty in doing so at the moment — we have heard that the Archmage may have somehow snubbed Kimus. One of our number briefly encountered a Herald of the All-Seeing Eye near the border between Sermersuaq and Skarsind after following the guidance of the runes there; the creature seemed unwilling to cross into Sermersuaq, where there is still a shroud. It considered the shroud to be actively harmful, even lethal, for it to travel under; while it lingered there, it stated to the seer that Kimus could not perceive the Archmage of Day and that attempts to communicate with him had met with no reply, and this had displeased the Eternal significantly.
