My name is Vordeth, Shaman of the Ghule. I send you this Winged Messenger with two purposes.

As I am sure you know, we Thule have needed to withdraw from Hercynia due to the fortunes of war. So be it. However, there is a small warband, the Rhino's Tusks, who are trapped behind enemy lines in Treji. I am writing to request that they be granted safe passage out of Hercynia. This does not affect the state of war between us, but is a consideration we may be able to return some day.
