Greetings from the Voivode of Chains, the Grand Herald of Ephisis, the great patron of the sentient species of the mortal realm, the munificent Pharam Vex!

I write on behalf of my master, who wishes to express his pleasure at having met you at the solstice just passed. He hereby offers the following discourse. You will not be bound to any agreement, contract or stipulations for reading this letter; no terms or conditions apply.

I understand that my master spoke to you about the potential for binding Autumn spirits into ushabti to improve their efficacy, and that you also inquired about the possibility of purchasing property in the City of Gold and Lead. He wishes to pass on two pieces of information to you regarding this. The first is that my master has consulted with his owner, the Sovereign Lady of the City of Gold and Lead, and Ephisis has made her decision clear on the matter. The Grand Plutocrat is not interested in relinquishing any land or structure property in her city-domain to any mortals under any circumstances. It is possible that her decision may change at a later date but, for now, the High Merchant will not countenance any such sale.

The second is that, should my master be placed under Amity by the Conclave and were the Senate's current strong statement opposing slavery in all its forms to be overturned, diminished or otherwise softened in the form of a fresh Statement of Intent, then he has a functional method of implementing the enhancement of ushabti with Autumn spirits that you would be able to undertake. Were a Needle of Brass to be built as a structure in Spiral - a vessel-forge through which ushabti could be processed - and that structure gifted to my master, the Maître de la Cage de Golde would staff it with a cabal of Heralds who would oversee the binding and maintenance of the drudge-vessel ushabti.
